THE 62nd ANNUAL AWARDS SHOW AT THE NEWTON FREE LIBRARY

September 2 to September 29, 2011

Reception: Tuesday, September 6, 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm

Registrations for the library show are due by July 15. Complete the registration form below and send to Carole Slattery, 558 Grove Street, Newton Lower Falls, MA, 02462, with a \$15 hanging fee (checks payable to NAA). Space will be limited to 70 artists and will be on a first come, first served basis. No waiting list will be kept. Questions can be addressed to Carole Slattery at carole@slattery.com or 617 332 7397.

Please note, NAA membership must be renewed in advance by July 1. Please send your renewal or new membership to Bernice Auslander, 16 Everett St, Newton, MA 02459 with a check made out to Newton Art Association or NAA. We cannot accept membership renewals at the library. Dues are \$30 for artists, \$15 for students.

Exhibiting members are asked to volunteer for a job to help with the hanging of the show or with the reception.

Drop off will be between 9:00 and 10:15 AM on Thursday, September 1 at the Newton Library.

Pick up will be 9:00 -10:00 AM on Friday September 30. NOTE: This is the second day of Rosh Hashanah. Please arrange for someone to pick up your work if you are unable to do so.

Reception and Awards will be Tuesday night, September 6, 7:00 - 8:30 PM.

The show will officially open to the public on September 2 and close on the 29th.

Rules for exhibiting:

- Membership in NAA must be current with all fees paid by dates they are due.
- Original art work only (no copies), completed within the last three years and not previously exhibited at a NAA show.
- All work must be neatly presented. Mats must be white, off white or other neutral colors and frames must be wood or white, black, silver, gold. No brightly colored frames or mats. No wet or tacky paintings will be accepted.
- Works on paper must be framed, under plexi or glass. Unframed paintings must be finished on the sides.
- Ready to hang with wire, and labeled with artist's name, title and price on the back. The Library advises against using glass. Works with glass are hung at the artist's risk and liability for personal injury and damage.
- Maximum size of 28" X 36" including frame, or a maximum total of 1008 square inches; minimum 8" X 10", unframed. Smaller work can be considered for the showcases.
- Sculpture must be secured safely, with artists providing their own stand.
- No Nudes
- Work must remain in exhibit at the library until pick up time (September 30).
- The NAA receives 20% of all sales

The downstairs library cases are available for displaying three-dimensional artwork, jewelry, or other small pieces. Items placed in cases cannot be more than 10 inches tall.
