Tom Sutherland

Tom Sutherland has a BA in Civil Engineering from Northeastern University. After spending 12 years in the field, he turned to woodworking and began a full time career of carved sign making. He estimates that he has designed and produced over 4,000 signs. In 1999 he discovered the medium of watercolor and has been hooked ever since.

Primarily self-taught, Tom began a more structured approach to watercolor with artist Jack Jones of Danvers. He also studied with international artist, Alvaro Castagnet. Now he has a style that "unleashes his passion for watercolor".

Mr. Sutherland is the president of the Reading Art Association & the Melrose Arts & Cultural Association. His painting style has developed into a very impressionistic representation of coastal landscapes and cityscapes. Many of his paintings depict urban street scenes or scenes from European travels.

He exhibits his work on a regular basis throughout the North Shore winning several awards. His paintings currently hang in private collections in the United States, Great Britain & Germany.

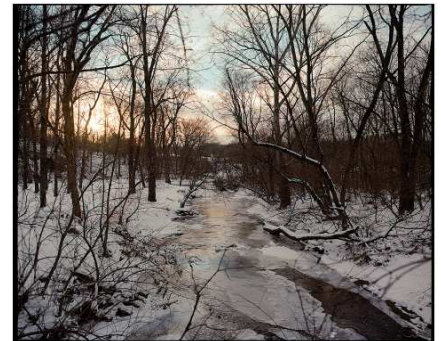

Rules for exhibiting:

1. Membership in NAA must be current with all fees paid by dates they are due.
2. Original art work only (no copies).
3. All work must be neatly presented. Mats must be white, off white or other neutral colors and frames must be wood or white, black, silver, gold. No brightly colored frames or mats. No wet or tacky paintings will be accepted.
4. Works on paper must be framed. We strongly recommend that they be framed under acrylic (Plexiglas, Lucite, etc.) The NAA advises against using glass. Works with glass are hung at the artist's risk and liability for personal injury and damage. Pastels are excepted.
5. Unframed paintings must be finished on the sides.
6. Works must be ready to hang with WIRE, and labeled with artist name, title and price on the

8. Work must remain on exhibit until pick up time (TBD)
9. The NAA receives 20% of all sales

The NAA reserves the right to refuse non-compliant entries.

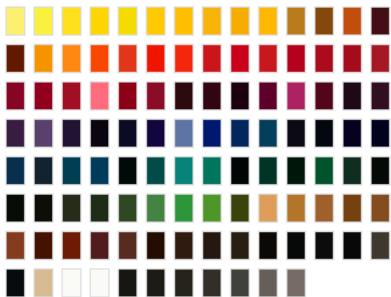

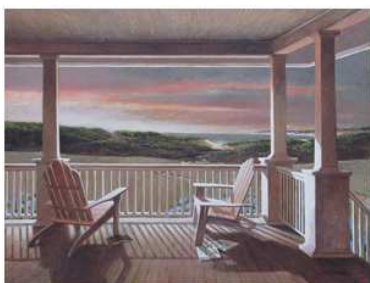
